"Water changed into wine"

By changing the jars filled with water into wine our Lord did two things: he provided drink to the wedding guests and he showed that, through baptism, people were going to be filled with the Holy Spirit. The Lord himself declared this elsewhere when he said: "New wine into fresh wineskins!" (Mt 9:17). The fresh wineskins stand, in fact, for baptismal purity, the wine of the Holy Spirit's grace.

Catechumens, pay particular attention to me. Your minds, which are ignorant as yet of the Trinity, are like water that is cold. They must be warmed, like wine, with the heat of the sacrament of baptism so as to transform a liquid that is poor and valueless into rich and precious grace. Like wine, let us acquire a good taste and sweet aroma, then we shall be able to say together with the apostle Paul: "We are indeed the good aroma of Christ for God" (2Cor 2:15). Before baptism the catechumen resembles still water, cold and colorless..., useless, unable to restore strength. If kept too long water deteriorates, stagnates, turns foul... The Lord said: "No one can enter the Kingdom of God without being born again of water and the Spirit" (Jn 3:5).

The baptized faithful are like wine that is strong and red. Every created thing deteriorates with time; wine alone improves as it ages. Daily it loses its sharpness and acquires a bouquet full of mellowness, with a deep flavor. Christians, too, as time passes, lose the sharpness of their sinful life and acquire the wisdom and goodness of the divine Trinity.

"El agua cambiada en vino"

Cambiando el agua que llenaba las tinajas, en vino, el Salvador ha hecho dos cosas: ha provisto a los invitados a las bodas de una bebida y ha hecho el signo de que, por el bautismo, los hombres quedarían llenos del Espíritu Santo. El mismo Señor lo ha declarado en otra parte, diciendo: "¡A odres nuevos, vino nuevo!" (Mt 9,17). En efecto, los odres nuevos significan la pureza del bautismo, el vino, la gracia del Espíritu Santo .

Catecúmenos, prestad una particular atención. Vuestro espíritu que todavía no conoce a la Trinidad se parece al agua fría. Es necesario calentarla con el calor del sacramento del bautismo, como se hace con un vino, para transformar un líquido pobre y sin valor en gracia preciosa y rica. Como el vino, adquirimos buen sabor y aroma de dulzura; entonces podremos decir con el apóstol Pablo: "Para Dios somos el buen olor de Cristo" (2Co 2,15). El catecúmeno, antes de su bautismo, se parece al agua que duerme, fría y sin color..., inútil, incapaz de dar energía. conservada durante largo tiempo, el agua se altera, corrompe, se vuelve fétida... El Señor ha dicho: "el que no nazca de nuevo del agua y del Espíritu, no puede entrar en el Reino de los cielos" (Jn 3,5).

El fiel bautizado se parece a un vino vigoroso y rojo. Todas las cosas de la creación con el tiempo se estropean, tan sólo el vino mejora envejeciendo. Pierde cada día de su aspereza, y adquiere una textura llena de suavidad, de un rico sabor. Igualmente el cristiano, a medida que pasa el tiempo pierde la aspereza de su vida pecadora, adquiere la sabiduría y la benevolencia de la Trinidad divina.
