Saint Andrew of Crete (660-740), monk and Bishop
Homily for Palm Sunday PG 97, 989-993 (trans. breviary)

"See, your king is coming to you" (Zac 9, 9; Mt 21, 5)

Come, come, and let us go up together to the Mount of Olives. Together let us meet Christ, who is returning today from Bethany and going of his own accord to that holy and blessed passion to complete the mystery of our salvation. And so he comes, willingly taking the road to Jerusalem, he who came down from the heights for us, to raise us who lie in the depths to exaltation with him, as the revealing word says: "above all authority and rule and power and above every name that is named" (Eph 1:21). He comes without display, without boast. For, as the prophet says, "He will not contend or shout out, and no one will hear his voice" (Is 42:2). He is gentle and lowly, and his entrance is humble...

Then, let us run with him as he presses on to his passion. Let us imitate those who have gone out to meet him, not scattering olive branches or garments or palms in his path but spreading ourselves before him as best we can with humility of soul and upright purpose. So may we welcome the Word as he comes (Jn 1:9); so may God, who cannot be contained within any bounds, be contained within us.

For he is pleased to have shown us this gentleness, he who is gentle and who "rides upon the setting sun" (Ps 56[57]:12), which refers to our extreme lowliness. He is pleased to come and live with us and to raise us up or bring us back to him through the word that unites to God.

San Andrés de Creta (660-740), monje y obispo
Homilía para el Domingo de Ramos, PG 97, 989-993

"He aquí que viene a ti tu rey." (Za 9,9; Mt 21,5)

Venid, y al mismo tiempo que ascendemos al monte de los Olivos, salgamos al encuentro de Cristo, que vuelve hoy de Betania y, por propia voluntad, se apresura hacia su venerable y dichosa pasión, para llevar a plenitud el misterio de la salvación de los hombres. Porque el que va libremente hacia Jerusalén es el mismo que por nosotros, los hombres, bajó del cielo, para levantar consigo a los que yacíamos en lo más profundo y colocarnos, como dice la Escritura, por encima de todo principado, potestad, fuerza y dominación, y por encima de todo nombre conocido (cf Ef 1,21). Y viene, no como quien busca su gloria por medio de la fastuosidad y de la pompa. No porfiará, dice, no gritará, no voceará por las calles, sino que será manso y humilde, y se presentará sin espectacularidad alguna.

Ea, pues, corramos a una con quien se apresura a su pasión, e imitemos a quienes salieron a su encuentro. Y no para extender por el suelo, a su paso, ramos de olivo, vestiduras o palmas, sino para prosternarnos nosotros mismos, con la disposición más humillada de que seamos capaces y con el más limpio propósito, de manera que acojamos al Verbo que viene, y así logremos captar a aquel Dios que nunca puede ser totalmente captado por nosotros.

Alegrémonos, pues, porque se nos ha presentado mansamente el que es manso y que asciende sobre el ocaso de nuestra ínfima vileza, para venir hasta nosotros y convivir con nosotros, de modo que pueda, por su parte, llevarnos hasta la familiaridad con él.
