On November 11th the Church celebrates the feast day of the Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary in the Temple. Tradition says that Mary's parents took her to the Temple when she was a small child to present her to God.

God: This is where the adventure begins for Mary, and this is where the adventure begins for each one of us. On this feast Mary reminds us of something that can easily get overlooked in this precocious world our children grow up in. God calls people of all ages to begin this adventure, to respond to His endless Love with their own small love. Mary shows us how. At the age of a small child she made a conscious decision to choose God, and she never went back on that choice. She chose Him for what he is: Love. She simply loved Him and tried to reflect that love on the people around her. The Church has called Mary, *Beloved Daughter of the Most High*. In her *Magnificat song* she recounts how the "Most High" has looked upon her in her "lowliness," chosen her and "done great things for her."

God sees us as we are too, he also loves us as we are, chooses us as we are and does great things for us. With the help of his grace, each one of us will get to sing our own *Magnificat* someday, to tell about our own remarkable adventure with God. We'll look back and be able to see the constant presence of God's loving providence that accompanied us in every moment of our life.

Let's begin right now. Mary began her divine adventure as a small child – and all of our children can too - but aren't we all small-aged children at the start of every new moment. In all of those moments we can also make a deliberate choice of the God who loves us and calls us, and we can choose to respond to his call by loving the people He puts around us.
