From Our Pastor



We only have two weeks left on our Lenten journey that began on Ash Wednesday when our foreheads were smeared with ashes and Jesus invited us with his Words to “*Repent, and believe in the gospel*” (Mark 1:15). The coming of Jesus into our world marks the beginning of a new era, the era of grace and salvation, the coming of God’s kingdom. His words here invite us to embrace this good news and have the life of God’s kingdom.

And he right away shows us how: repent, that is, change direction and believe in the gospel (the good news!). When we accept and live out Jesus’s words they bring about a change in our thinking – repentance. They instill in us the very sentiments of Jesus toward people and the world. How is it that the gospel can work such a miracle of conversion and give us a new life? The secret lies in the mystery contained in Jesus’s words. They’re not simply commands or even advice. Jesus actually lives in his words, and it’s Jesus himself who speaks to us in them. By receiving his words into our hearts and living them, we’re one with him and he lives in us. This is why we should welcome Jesus’s urgent invitation, especially during these last two weeks of Lent before the celebration of his life-giving death and resurrection.

“Repent, and believe in the Gospel.”

Some of us might consider the words of the Gospel to be too high or difficult, too far removed from real life and our ordinary way of thinking. And so we might feel discouraged from even hearing them. Perhaps this is because we think that we’re the ones that have to move our mountain of doubt and disbelief all by ourselves. But all it really takes is an honest try, living out at least one of his Words. The Word of God is a presence of God. When we live even one of his words, it cleanses us, changes us, strengthens and gladdens us. We could begin with the Word “love” which is the essence of the Gospel.

Repent, and believe the Gospel! Think of how much light this single sentence could give to us today. Every time we come up against our own weaknesses or those of others; every time that following Jesus seems to be an impossible task or even absurd; every time that problems threaten to overwhelm us, this Word could be a breath of fresh air, an encouragement from Jesus to begin again. Then, it would only be a matter of a small act of love, a quick change of direction to get us out of ourselves and place us in God where we would experience a different life, the life of God’s kingdom.

The teachers and children of the CCE here at St Mary’s have been sharing their experiences with one another of putting the Word of God into practice with the help of the Cube of Love. This simple sharing of the Word has formed them into a small community, a small but vibrant portion of God’s kingdom. Such little chunks of God’s kingdom could sprout up anywhere, wherever love, the essence of the Gospel is lived and shared.

De Parte de Nuestro Pastor



Solo tenemos dos semanas más en nuestro viaje de Cuaresma que comenzó el miércoles de ceniza cuando nuestras frentes fueron manchadas con las cenizas y Jesús nos invitó con sus palabras “Arrepiéntete, y cree en el Evangelio” (Marcos 1:15). La venida de Jesús a nuestro mundo marca el principio de una nueva era, la era de gracia y salvación, la venida del reino de Dios. Sus palabras aquí nos invitan a abrazar la buena nueva y tener la vida en el reino de Dios.

Y El enseguida nos mostró como: arrepiéntete, eso es, cambia de dirección y cree en el evangelio (la buena nueva!). Cuando nosotros aceptamos y vivimos las palabras de Jesús ellas traen un cambio en nuestro pensamiento – arrepentimiento. Ellas instilan en nosotros los mismos sentimientos de Jesús hacia las personas y el mundo.

Como es que el evangelio puede trabajar tal milagro de conversión y darnos una nueva vida? El secreto está en el misterio contenido en las palabras de Jesús. Ellas no son simplemente mandatos o inclusive consejos. Jesús actualmente vive en sus palabras, y es Jesús mismo el que nos habla en ellas. Al recibir sus palabras en nuestro corazón y viviéndolas, somos uno con El y Él vive en nosotros. Por esto debemos darle la bienvenida a la invitación urgente de Jesús, especialmente durante estas dos semanas de Cuaresma antes de la celebración de su vida – dando muerte y resurrección. “Arrepiéntete, y cree en el Evangelio.”

Algunos de nosotros consideramos las palabras del Evangelio muy altas o difíciles, muy removidas de la vida real y nuestro modo de pensar ordinario. Y así podríamos sentirnos desalentados inclusive de escucharlas. Tal vez esto es porque nosotros pensamos que somos nosotros los que tenemos que mover nuestra montaña de duda e incredulidad nosotros solos. Pero en realidad solo toma honestamente tratar, Por lo menos vivir una de sus palabras. La Palabra de Dios es la presencia de Dios. Cuando vivimos por lo menos uno de sus palabras, nos limpia, nos cambia, nos fortalece y nos regocija. Podríamos comenzar con la palabra “amor” la cual es la esencia del Evangelio.

Arrepiéntete, y cree en el Evangelio! Piensa cuanta luz esta simple oración nos podría dar hoy. Cada vez que nos enfrentamos a nuestra propia debilidad o la de otros; cada vez que seguir a Jesús parece una tarea imposible o inclusive absurda; cada vez que los problemas nos amenazan con abrumarnos, esta Palabra puede ser un aliento de aire puro, es ánimo de parte de Jesús para empezar de nuevo. Luego, entonces seria cosa de un pequeño acto de amor, un cambio rápido de dirección para sacarnos de nosotros mismos y ponernos en Dios donde nosotros experimentaríamos una vida diferente, la vida del reino de Dios.

Las maestras y los niños de CCE aquí en Santa María han estado compartiendo sus experiencias poniendo la Palabra de Dios en práctica con la ayuda el cubo de amor. Esta sencillo compartir de la Palabra los ha transformado en una pequeña comunidad, una pequeña pero vibrante porción del reino de Dios. Tales pequeños pedazos del reino de Dios pueden aparecer por dondequiera, donde el amor, la esencia del Evangelio es vivida y compartida.

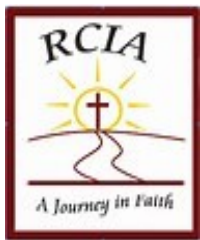

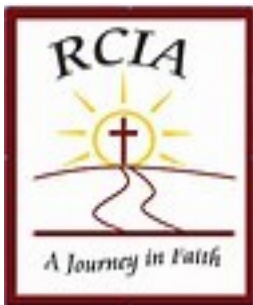
