From Our Pastor



In 1976, Chiara Lubich, the founder of a great movement known as the Work of Mary, explained the relationship between the Eucharist and the Trinity. When I first heard her explanation, it completely changed my understanding of the Eucharist and my relationship with God as Trinity. Hoping to effect the insight in you, here is a synthesis of what she said: 'The Eucharist does not only produce effects that are beautiful and good, effects of sanctity and love; nor is its primary purpose that of increasing our unity with God and with one another, and so of serving to nurture the presence of Jesus in the midst. Yes, this is true too. But the task of the Eucharist is something else.

The purpose of the Eucharist is to make us God (by participation). It mingles Christ's flesh, which is given life by the Holy Spirit and life-giving, with our flesh, and thus divinizes us in soul and in body. Therefore, as St. Thomas Aquinas said, it makes us God. Now God can only be in God. That is why the Eucharist takes a Christian who has worthily received it into the bosom of the Father; it places us in the Trinity, in Jesus.

At the same time, the Eucharist does not do this with just one person, but with many, and since they are all God, they are no longer many but one, (...) They are God and all together in God. They are one with Him, lost in Him.

And this reality which the Eucharist brings about is the Church. What is the Church? It is the oneness brought about by the Eucharist. To use a human expression, to express it in human terms - with an example from Scripture - we could say that the Church is a body whose head is the glorified Christ. But just as Christ is in the heart of the Trinity, so the Church is called to be - and already is, here on earth in those members in whom the Eucharist is at work - in the bosom of the Father. And if in part it is not there yet, it is on its way.

Human beings, then, (Christians) take all of creation with them there because the human person sums up creation.

Everything which has come out of God returns, therefore, through the Eucharist, into the Trinity.'

So on this Trinity Sunday, let us seek to approach Jesus in the Eucharist consciously recognizing all that it implies in our personal lives individually, and all of us together as Church.

De Parte de Nuestro Párroco

Personal Parroquial



En el 1976, Chiara Lubich, fundadora de un gran movimiento llamado 'La Obra de María, explicó la relación entre la Eucaristía y la Trinidad. Cuando la escuché por primera vez, cambió completamente mi relación con la Eucaristía y con Dios como Trinidad. Aquí esta una síntesis de lo que dijo: 'La Eucaristía no solamente produce frutos hermosos, buenos, de santidad, de amor. Ni siquiera tiene como primer objetivo aumentar nuestra unidad con Dios y entre nosotros, sirviendo, por lo tanto, para alimentar la presencia de Jesús en medio. Sí, también esto.

Pero la función de la Eucaristía es otra.

La Eucaristía tiene la finalidad de hacernos Dios (por participación) mezclando la carne vivificada por el Espíritu Santo y vivificante de Cristo con la nuestra, nos diviniza en el alma y en el cuerpo. Nos hace Dios, por lo tanto.

Ahora bien, Dios no puede estar más que en Dios. Por eso la Eucaristía hace entrar al cristiano que se alimenta de ella dignamente, en el seno del Padre, coloca al hombre en la Trinidad, en Jesús.

Al mismo tiempo la Eucaristía no hace esto solamente con una persona, sino con muchas, las cuales, siendo todas Dios, ya no son muchas personas, sino 'una'. Son Dios y todas juntas están en Dios. Son una sola cosa con Él, están anuladas en Él.

Ahora bien, esta realidad que la Eucaristía realiza, es la Iglesia.

¿Qué es la Iglesia? Es el 'Uno' provocado por el amor recíproco de los cristianos y por la Eucaristía. La Iglesia está formada por hombres divinizados, hechos Dios, unidos al Cristo, que es Dios y unidos entre sí. Si quisiéramos expresar todo en términos humanos - con un ejemplo que las Escrituras usan - la Iglesia es un cuerpo, cuya cabeza es Cristo glorioso.

Pero como Cristo está en el seno de la Trinidad, la Iglesia también está llamada a estar - y lo está ya desde esta Tierra en los miembros en que la Eucaristía actúa - en el seno del Padre. Y si en parte todavía no lo está, está viajando en esa dirección. Además el hombre arrastra consigo toda la creación, porque es su síntesis.

Todo lo que ha salido de Dios vuelve, por lo tanto, por la Eucaristía, a la Trinidad.'

Así que durante este domingo de la Santísima Trinidad, y por toda la semana, procuremos acercarnos dignamente a Jesús en la Eucaristía reconociendo conscientemente todo lo que implica en nuestras vidas personales individualmente, y todos juntos como Iglesia.
