From Our Pastor



Last weekend I shared some thoughts on the Eucharist taken from the mystical writings of Chiara Lubich: how it divinizes us, makes us God both individually and as a community; that it takes a Christian who has worthily received it into the bosom of the Father; it places us in the Trinity, in Jesus. And the Trinity is a family. So another way of putting it would be to say that Jesus in the Eucharist makes us a family, his family, and family means mutual love. Love will forever be the secret of the Christian life. Once we have learned how to love, we have learned it all. The Eucharist tells us that we are a family, that we should love one another.

Jesus comes to everyone at Holy Communion in all the churches of the world. He comes with all of his love, totally there for each and all, totally there for every person of every land. He teaches us that all people are equal, all of them children of God, all of them possible brothers and sisters, followers, members of His Mystical Body. Jesus does not have racial preferences; he does not discriminate. Just by being there in the Eucharist, Jesus shows us how far our love should go: it should aspire to being a universal family in Him.

This week let us try to honor Jesus in the Eucharist by loving our neighbors who have become our brothers and sisters through Jesus our invisible Brother. Let us love them as he has loved us. In the Eucharist he teaches us that love is “making yourself one.” Making yourself one in the small, insignificant things, in the things that are not very important to you, but interesting to others. In the Eucharist, Jesus does this so splendidly! He silently becomes bread and wine to enter into everyone. So that he can be one with everyone, to serve everyone, to love everyone. So He makes Himself one to the point of letting Himself be consumed. This is what love is: making yourself one with your neighbor in everything except sin: “I have made myself all things to all people in order to bring them to Christ” (1 Cor 9:19).

De Parte de Nuestro Párroco



La semana pasada compartí algunas reflexiones sobre la Eucaristía tomadas de los escritos místicos de Chiara Lubich: cómo nos diviniza, nos hace Dios individualmente y como comunidad. Llevo al cristiano que lo ha recibido dignamente al seno del Padre; Nos sitúa en la Trinidad, en Jesús. Y la Trinidad es una familia. Así que otra manera de decirlo es que Jesús en la Eucaristía nos hace una familia, su familia y una familia significa amor mutuo. El amor será para siempre el secreto de la vida cristiana. Una vez que hayamos aprendido a amar, lo hemos aprendido todo. La Eucaristía nos dice que somos una familia, que debemos amarnos los unos a los otros.

Jesús viene a todos en la Santa Comunión en todas las iglesias del mundo. Él viene con todo su amor, y está totalmente allí para cada uno y para cada persona sobre la tierra. Él nos enseña que todas las personas son iguales, todos hijos de Dios, todos posibles hermanos y hermanas, discípulos, miembros de Su Cuerpo Místico. Jesús no tiene preferencias entre las razas; Él no discrimina. Sólo por estar allí en la Eucaristía, Jesús nos muestra hasta dónde debe ir nuestro amor: debemos aspirar a ser una familia universal en Él.

Esta semana intentemos honrar a Jesús en la Eucaristía amando a nuestros prójimos para lleguemos a sentir que somos verdaderos hermanos y hermanas a través de Jesús, nuestro Hermano invisible. Amémoslos como él nos ha amado. En la Eucaristía él nos enseña que el amor se “hace uno”. Haciéndonos uno en las cosas pequeñas, insignificantes, en las cosas que no me parecerán muy importantes, pero que son interesantes para los demás. ¡En la Eucaristía, Jesús hace esto tan espléndidamente! Él silenciosamente se convierte en pan y vino para entrar en cada uno. Para que pueda hacerse uno con todos, servir a todos, amar a todos. Así, Él se hace uno hasta el punto de dejarse consumir. Esto es el amor: hacerse uno con el prójimo en todo excepto en el pecado. “me he hecho esclavo de todos para ganar a los más que pueda” (I Cor 9,19).
