From Our Pastor



During the season of Advent we are invited to prepare for the coming of Jesus. The very word “advent” is a Latin translation of the Greek word “Parousia” [or coming] that is used to refer to the Second Coming of Jesus at the end of Time. That is when he will judge between the sheep and the goats. The season of Advent comes four Sundays before Christmas, the day when we celebrate Jesus’s first coming among us on Christmas Day.

Advent is also a time of preparation for His real but spiritual coming into our midst again this Christmas. Jesus would like to come among two or more of us wherever we are gathered in His name. This presence of Jesus is a mystical one – real and sensible to the eyes of the soul. His presence in our midst depends on our willingness to live out what He calls his “own” “new” “commandment:” *“This is my command: love one another as I have loved you” (Jn 15:12)*. What should we do, then, to be prepared for His coming into our midst and not only into our hearts and imaginations on Christmas day, but at every moment of our life? He told us: We should be gathered together in living His new commandment and being open to His presence among us. That is what it means to unite in his name. Notice that his new commandment requires reciprocal love.

Let’s begin right away to live in such a manner that Jesus can truly be among us in the way He wants: *“For where two or three are gathered in my name, I am there in their midst” (Mt 18:20)*. Advent is also a special time for remembering and celebrating Mary’s role in bringing Jesus into the world for the first time. What better way to celebrate her than to imitate her in bringing Jesus into the world mystically, as she did physically? Living with Jesus in our midst, He will make every day Christmas and fill our small world with his Light. May Mary, Mother of the Light, pray for us.

De Parte de Nuestro Párroco



Durante el tiempo de Adviento, se nos invita a prepararnos para la venida de Jesús. La misma palabra “adviento” [venida] es una traducción latina de la palabra griega “Parusía” que se usa para referirse a la Segunda Venida de Jesús al final de los tiempos. Es entonces que Jesús separará las ovejas de los cabritos. El Adviento empieza cuatro domingos antes de la Navidad, el día en que celebramos la primera venida de Jesús entre nosotros.

El Adviento también es un tiempo de preparación para Su llegada espiritual pero real entre nosotros esta Navidad. A Jesús le gustaría venir entre dos o más de nosotros dondequiera que estemos reunidos en Su nombre. Esta presencia de Jesús es mística, real, y visible a los ojos del alma. Su presencia entre nosotros depende de nuestra voluntad de vivir lo que Él llama “*su mandamiento nuevo*”: “*Este es mi mandamiento: Amense los unos a los otros, como yo los he amado*” (Jn 15:12). ¿Qué debemos hacer, entonces, para prepararnos a su venida en medio nuestro en cada momento de nuestra vida y no solo a su venida en nuestros corazones e imaginaciones esta Navidad? Él nos dijo: debemos reunirnos para vivir su nuevo mandamiento y estar abiertos a su presencia entre nosotros. Eso es lo que significa unirse en su nombre. Noten que su nuevo mandamiento requiere el amor recíproco.

Comencemos de inmediato a vivir de tal manera que Jesús pueda estar verdaderamente entre nosotros de la manera que Él más lo desea: “*Pues donde están dos o tres reunidos en mi Nombre, allí estoy yo, en medio de ellos*” (Mt 18, 20). El Adviento es también un momento especial para recordar y celebrar el papel que María tuvo al traer a Jesús al mundo por primera vez. ¿Qué mejor manera de celebrarla que de imitarla al traer a Jesús al mundo místicamente, como lo hizo ella físicamente? Viviendo con Jesús en medio de nosotros, Él hará que cada día sea Navidad y llene nuestro pequeño mundo con su Luz. ¡Que María, Madre de la Luz, ore por nosotros!
