From Our Pastor

The month of May is traditionally dedicated to Mary. This month we'll be bringing flowers to church as signs of our affection for her, but we'll also bring spiritual flowers, the acts of love we do as we live according to the Cube of Love, which teaches us how to love as God loves.

The Cube of Love also teaches us to love as Mary loves. Mary was always the *first to love*. When she learned that her cousin Elizabeth was pregnant. She "immediately" got up and went "in haste" to help her cousin.

Mary loves everyone. While Jesus died on the cross, she took us as her children. Now, people of every land and culture claim her as their own. In Mexico she's the *Virgencita, La Guadalupana, La Reina de los Mexicanos*. In the U.S.A. she's the Immaculate Conception and Mother of Light.

Mary sees Jesus in everyone, because Jesus is the invisible Brother among us who makes us all brothers and sisters of each other. It's good to remember Mary's silent presence, watching over Jesus in us just as she did in Nazareth where He grew in wisdom, stature and grace.

Mary loves her neighbor. At the Wedding of Cana when the wine ran out, she went to Jesus because she knew he could help. Perhaps moved by her love for the couple, even though it wasn't "his hour" to reveal his glory, he performed the miracle and changed water into wine. Mary's love for her neighbors is able to influence her Son.

Mary makes herself one. In Guadalupe, she made herself one with the local bishop who loved Roses of Castilla, which he could never get to grow in Mexico. She sent Juan Diego to the bishop with his *tilma* full of those roses. She wore the royal colors of a native deity and included local gods in the image. Like St Paul, Mary makes herself all things to all people (1 Cor. 9:23).

Mary loves her enemies. She was intimately united to the sufferings of her Son as she "stood" by his cross and He took our sins upon himself, making us one with the Father and one another.

Mary lives the new commandment: Love one another as I have loved you. After the annunciation, she ran to her cousin Elizabeth's home to help her with her pregnancy. After the Resurrection, she went to the Upper Room where the disciples were gathered in mutual love (Jn. 13:34). On Pentecost, the Holy Spirit descended on her a second time, this time in the midst of a community of brothers and sisters gathered around her. Once again, she brought forth the Body of Christ, this time in the form of the Church, the home and school of communion.

What better way to honor our Mother than to let her see herself in us, both individually and as a community, as we try to love as she loves.

De Parte de Nuestro Párroco



El Mes de mayo es tradicionalmente dedicado a Maria. Este mes vamos a traer flores a la iglesia como signo de nuestro afecto por ella, pero también vamos a traer flores espirituales, es decir, los actos de amor que hacemos mientras vivimos según el cubo de amor, que nos enseña a amar como Dios ama.

El cubo de amor también nos enseña a amar como Maria ama. Maria siempre *fue la primera en amar*. Cuando se enteró de que su prima Isabel estaba embarazada, partió y fue sin demora para ayudar a su prima.

María ama a todos. Mientras Jesus murió en la Cruz, ella nos tomó como sus hijos. Ahora, la gente de todas las tierras y culturas la reclaman como suya. En México es *la virgencita, la Guadalupeana, la reina de los mexicanos*. En los Estados Unidos es la Inmaculada Concepción y madre de la luz.

María ve a Jesús en todos, porque Jesús ese Hermano invisible entre nosotros que nos hace a todos hermanos y hermanas el uno del otro. Es bueno recordar la presencia silenciosa de Maria, observando a Jesus en Nosotros tal como lo hizo en Nazaret, donde él creció en sabiduría, estatura y gracia.

María ama a su prójimo. En la boda de Caná cuando se terminó el vino, fue a Jesús porque sabía que podía ayudar. Tal vez movido por su amor a la pareja, a pesar de que no era “su hora” para revelar su gloria, Él realizó el milagro y cambió el agua en vino. El amor de Maria por su prójimo es capaz de influir en su hijo.

María se hace una. En Guadalupe, ella se hizo una con el obispo local que amaba las rosas de Castilla, que nunca podrían llegar a crecer en México. Envío a Juan Diego al obispo con su tilma llena de esas rosas. La virgen usó los colores reales de una deidad nativa e incluía a los dioses locales en la imagen. Como San Pablo, María se hace todo para todos, para ganar por lo menos a algunos (1 Cor 9:22).

María ama a sus enemigos. Así como Jesús perdonó a los enemigos que lo habían crucificado, también María los perdonó por haberle hecho eso a su propio hijo. Además, ella estaba íntimamente unida a los sufrimientos de su hijo mientras “estaba” al pie de la cruz y Él tomó nuestros pecados, haciéndonos uno con el padre y el uno con el otro. Como madre del redentor María participó en nuestra redención.

María vive el nuevo mandamiento: Ámense unos a otros, así como yo los he amado... Después de la resurrección, ella fue al cenáculo donde los discípulos se reunieron en el amor mutuo (Hc 1:14). En pentecostés, el Espíritu Santo descendió sobre ella por segunda vez, esta vez en medio de una comunidad de hermanos y hermanas reunidos alrededor de ella. Una vez más, dio a luz al cuerpo de Cristo, esta vez en la forma de la iglesia, el hogar y la escuela de la comunión.

¡Qué mejor modo de honrar a nuestra madre que el de dejarla verse en nosotros individualmente y como comunidad mientras tratamos de amar como ella ama!
